August	2009	Razadyne oral solution	Galantamine Hydrobromide	Treatment of mild to moderate dementia associated with Alzheimer's disease
August	2009	Catapres-TTS	Clonidine	Treatment of high blood pressure
September	2009	Starlix	Nateglinide	Treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus
September	2009	Plan B	Levonorgestrel	Prevention of pregnancy after unprotected sex or after failure of another birth control method
September	2009	Rowasa Kit	Mesalamine	Treatment of ulcerative colitis
October	2009	Prograf	Tacrolimus Anhydrous	Prevention of organ transplant rejection

Drug	Indication
Actoplus Met	Treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus
Duetact	Second-line treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus
Exforge HCT	Treatment of high blood pressure
Plan B One Step	Prevention of pregnancy after unprotected sex or after failure of another birth control method
Veramyst	Treatment of sneezing, itchy, runny or stuffy nose caused by hay fever

The following medications have been removed from the QUEST formulary:

Drug	Indication	Formulary alternatives
Beconase AQ	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Relief of stuffy nose, irritation, and discomfort of hay fever, other allergies, and other nasal problems2) Prevention of nasal polyps from growing back after surgical removal	Flunisolide, Fluticasone Propionate, Rhinocort AQ*, Veramyst** *requires prior trial of flunisolide and fluticasone **PA required for patients not between the ages of 2-4
